Arrive in choir room	5:00 AM	We will take attendance and load the bus. You are responsible for your garment bags and one item on the trailer. You should be in PJs or wearing your maroon jackets/grey shirts/jeans (no holes).
Leave Unity	5:30 AM	Some makeup and hair may be done on the bus, do not use sprays of any kind while on the bus. You may leave pillows and blankets on the bus for the ride home unless you are traveling home with parents.
Arrive at El Paso High School	7:30 AM	Unload the trailer FIRST. Then you may start getting ready.
Meet in Homeroom	8:00 AM	You must be dressed and ready to perform at this time. No jewelry. No nail polish (though it is recommended that you wear clear nail polish). We will do a line up at this time to approve hair and makeup. We will also do vocal warm ups.
