Community Guidelines for Residential Construction Projects

We appreciate the work that building contractors do to help beautify and improve our neighborhood. As you plan for and complete your construction project we ask that you observe a few basic rules of courtesy to our residents. Please review and communicate these guidelines to other workers on your project.

- Obey San Diego construction noise rules limiting construction activity, including work staging, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- Dispose of all cigarette butts and trash. Do not leave on property and streets.
- Avoid loud and foul language.
- Treat our residents with respect – no harassment of neighbors or passers-by.
- Don't block driveways or park in no parking zones.
- Use magnets at the end of each day to pick up nails or screws that may have fallen on the street or driveways.
- Ensure all storm water pollution protection measures are in place and maintained.
