



# Cutting Horse Contest Event 2020/2021

State/Province: Ohio

Cutting Horse Event is an event of the National High School Rodeo Association and must be offered in the state, district, province programs including their finals. Holding the Cutting is not an option in each program; however, the manner in which the All Around points are counted is an option. Either option will allow the state/province to qualify a full team of Cutting contestants to the NHSFR.

For the 2020-2021 National High School Rodeo Association year, our state/province has elected to handle the Cutting Horse Contest event in the following manner:

OPTION 1: Cutting Horse Event will be offered for each approved qualifying, practice and/or state/province or district rodeo. Cutting may be held in conjunction with the rodeo or held at a different time and location for each rodeo. Cutting must be offered the same number of times as all the other events, such as pole bending, bull riding, etc. If OPTION 1 is used, all points earned throughout the year and at the state/provincial finals will be applied toward the All Around.

OPTION 2: Cutting Horse Event must be offered a minimum three (3) times within each district and/or state/province and their finals. Only the points earned at the finals will count toward the All Around. Points earned at the qualifying events and the state/provincial finals will be used for the year end Cutting Champion.
