"Stargazer Lily" Original Colored Pencil Design Pattern#2021-1 Designed by Renette Dora Jodoin

Supplies Used:

Paper Options:

XL Canson Bristol Vellum
XL Canson Bristol Smooth
XL Recycled Bristol Two Distinct Sides
Strathmore Colored Pencil

Prismacolor Premier Colored Pencils:

Neon Yellow PC 1035
True Green PC 910
Grass Green PC 909
Dark Green PC 908
Olive Green PC 911
Neon Pink PC 1038
Magenta PC 930
Dahlia Purple PC 1009
Lavender PC 934
Sand PC 940
White PC 938
Chartreuse PC 989
Orange PC 918
Black PC 935



Other Supplies:

Pencil Sharpener-electric or handheld
Dusting brush
Container for pencil shavings for handheld sharpeners
Pigma Micron 05 Black or 02
Grey Graphite Transfer Paper
Tracing Paper
Stylus
#2 pencil or graphite pencil
Kneaded eraser or white vinyl eraser

Prep:

Transfer the pattern to the paper you selected from the options listed above. There are several ways to do this. The preferred method is to trace the drawing using transfer paper and then use grey graphite paper to transfer pattern onto your selected 9x12 sheet of paper. Clean up excess graphite lines or lines too dark with a kneaded or white vinyl eraser. Note when transferring the pattern to the selected 9x12 listed above, be sure not to press too hard to ensure you do not leave indentations into the paper that can not be removed and can effect pieces of your painting. Transfer lines should be light so that you can see them but not too dark to be able to cover them up.


MARCH MEETING PROGRAM BY Dora

The instructions were sent to members by email.

Programs: Our March program is the Stargazer Lily by Dora Jodoin. She has sent each of you a complete packet for the Stargazer Lily. This contains the list of Prismacolor Premier Colored Pencils and supplies to have on hand. This will be a new experience for some. I know we are all looking forward to this class.

The April program will be a Shara Reiner ornament. The ornament is a 4"X6" wood plaque. This ornament can be painted flat or with the Quikwood for dimension. Quikwood can be ordered from <u>janeallencreates.com</u>, Cupboard Distributing or Bear With us (if they still have it). A similar product is Kwikwood by J.B. Weld (Home Depot in the adhesion aisle). DecoArt Americana paints: Black, Whispering Turquoise, Indian Turquoise, Warm White, Hauser medium Green, Foliage Green, Blue Harbor, Deep Midnight Blue, Bright Salmon, Country Red, Deep Burgundy, True Ochre, Moon Yellow, Oyster Beige, Wedgewood Blue, Metallic Champagne Gold.

Other supplies are: Spray Vegetable oil (for use with Quikwood.), Wire hanger, a wood star or make one from Quikwood, Glass Glitter, Adherence medium. Before class prep, Sand and seal the wood piece. Base coat the entire wood board with black. Add the basic pattern outlines with transfer paper, not the details.





Zoom Instructions

Click on link to join the meeting. If needed, put in meeting ID and passcode. Select join with video.

If using iPad touch grid on the left upper side to allow you to see rows of attendees. Swipe to the left to see more or back to the right to see the previous group. On an phone it only shows four people and you have to swipe to see more.

Mute button is a mic icon with a slash going thru if muted. Touch the button to unmute. If someone is in the room with you, try to keep muted unless you are speaking. Especially if someone is teaching a project.

All should mute while someone is teaching a project unless they need to interrupt with a question.




