1. To qualify, all animals must be free of any evidence of infectious or contagious disease.
Superintendent identification -- Purebred animals must be identified by registry name and number, corresponding to the ear tag or tattoo number. Grade animals must be identified by farm-flock number, corresponding to the ear tag or tattoo number.

DEPARTMENT 4 -- SHEEP

2. Ages of animals will be reckoned from Sept. 1st -- that is born before August 31st will be one year old, and after Sept. 1st will be two years old, etc.
3. Any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions, must be removed from the fairgrounds.
4. Pen lambs consist of two ram lambs and two ewe lambs.
5. Flock lambs consist of one ram, any age; two ewe, one year and under two years; two ewe under one year.
6. Breeder's young flock consist of one ram lamb and two ewe lambs, all bred and owned by the exhibitor.
7. A Get of Sire consists of four breeding animals, any age or sex, the Get of One Sire. Get need not be owned by exhibitor.

NOTE: Fair may choose to list classes suggested by the American Goat Breeders Association in lieu of those listed here.

1. Get of Sire shall consist of three doe from a particular sire with not more than one under one year allowed and not more than one animal from every multiple bush allowed. Get of Sire need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Sire.
2. Produce of Dam shall consist of two doe of different ages. The produce of Dam need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Dam.
3. A Dairy Herd shall consist of three milking doe of one breed, any age.
4. The Senior Champion Class shall consist of all first place winners in the first classes, or Doe 1 year old and under 2, in milk and older animals.
5. The Junior, Champion Class shall consist of all first place winners in classes 2 and 3, or Doe one year old and under 2 years, not in milk and younger animals.
6. Grand Champion Class shall consist of best of breed in each division.
7. Only Doe entered in other classes may compete in Get of Sire, Produce of Dam and Milking Herd classes.
