Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

A 100% refund of the entry fee will be given for any bitch that comes into season with written notification from a veterinarian provided to the Trial Secretary.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20", 24" and 24C" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk through.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES**Classes Offered**

Premier Standard and Premier JWW, including the preferred classes, will be offered according to the entry form. (International Sweepstakes Classes will be offered when indicated in the premium and on the entry form). A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es).

Preferred Class Information You may not enter the same dog in preferred & regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

Move-ups, Errors, Confirmation Protocols Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the trial secretary in writing (mail or email) by **6 pm, Pacific time, Wednesday, Jan 8, 2020**. Requests for move-ups over the phone **will not be accepted.**

AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION**Awards**

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

First Place: Blue Ribbon ~ Second Place: Red Ribbon ~ Third Place: Yellow Ribbon
 Fourth Place: White Ribbon ~ Qualifying Score: Dark Green Rosette

MACH & PACH ribbons and bars will be presented to dogs completing those titles
If you & your dog are close to a MACH or PACH, please let a member of the trial committee know.

High Combined in Trial: Daisy Peel and Clear Mind Agility is providing prizes to the High Combined Scoring dogs in each jump height, Regular and Preferred!!!

High Scoring Dog will be determined by Time plus faults, combining the scores from All 4 Runs.

WORLD TEAM TRYOUT QUALIFICATIONS

ISC JWW Run #2 and ISC Standard Run #4 are designated as the World Team Tryout qualifying runs.

ISC Combined Class Winners Combined scores from ISC Jumpers and Standard classes at the above events will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award. To be eligible for the Combined ISC Class Award the team must have a minimum of one clean ISC run and a run that has a maximum of 5 course faults (no time faults allowed) for those scores to be used to compute the Combined Score. The Combined Class winner from the 12, 16 and 24 inch height is invited to attend Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfill the requirement of the 6/6 scores. The team must also send in all the required information with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility noted in this document (including an approved pedigree). The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

OBSTACLES AND EQUIPMENT

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. There will be no equipment familiarization at this trial. As of 9/1/06 AKC does not allow it. Rubberized contacts and break-away tires will be used at these trials.

Equipment

The equipment for this event is provided by Clear Mind Agility.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

SITE INFORMATION AND RULES

The show site is indoors on artificial turf. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog. **X-pens are NOT permitted at the show site.** Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring, excepting when in the fenced off leash area. A warm up area will be provided for all exhibitors.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. *Please NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS on the mats. Please wear/use clean, athletic footwear to preserve the flooring!*

Please drive slowly on the driveway so as to avoid bunnies, people, and dogs at play. When you enter the driveway, turn left when the driveway opens up – follow the reflective arrow that is pointing left toward the Hall. A map for parking can be found at <http://www.clearmindagility.com/wpcontent/uploads/2017/11/Clear-mind-agility-map-seminars.jpg> – if you see that parking in front of the Hall is filled, please park in one of the other parking areas, and be mindful of others who may arrive behind you.

Barking dogs must be kept quiet at all times in consideration of the neighbors.

CRATING INFORMATION

You may crate in the viewing loft or adjacent to the rings. There is no crating in the office in the arena. Crating space is very limited– Please stack crates when possible. We will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. **NO EX PENS Allowed.**

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if **notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial,** less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs. Bitches in season will receive 100% refund. **No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial.** Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- The Greater Clark County Kennel Club, Clear Mind Agility and K-9 Sports LLC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- The Greater Clark County Kennel Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
