Interim Directives

202.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a process to make immediate changes to district policy. The Blue Ridge Fire District will, as necessary, issue Interim Directives that will immediately modify or change and supersede the sections of this manual to which they pertain.

202.2 POLICY

It is the policy of the Blue Ridge Fire District to make any immediate changes to policy and procedure in accordance with any current collective bargaining agreement. Generally, the establishment of Interim Directives is management's prerogative but employee participation may be sought in the development of those policies. It is the policy of the District to comply with any meet-and-confer requirements between labor groups and authorized district representatives.

202.3 RESPONSIBILITIES

The Fire Chief shall issue all Interim Directives.

All district officers and/or supervisors shall be responsible for communicating Interim Directives to all members under their command and/or direct supervision.

Interim Directives will be rescinded upon incorporation into this manual.

All Interim Directives shall be reviewed periodically to authenticate or determine if they are currently applicable to the mission of the District.
