As promised, the Back to School donations were counted at the September meeting and I am totally "blown away" with your generosity. There was a total of **1,062 items** donated for underprivileged youngsters at Union Cross Elementary and Glenn High. Boy folks, you really out did yourselves! Everyone who participated please know you are part of making this school year better for so many children.

Our September mission projects were:

- \$100 of WOM funds were sent to the Next Step Ministries in Kernersville to help provide furnishings for the newer and larger ladies' and children's safe house.
- \$100 of WOM funds were directed to the Baptist Children's Home in Thomasville to assist with clothing and back to school needs for a resident child at that facility.
- Sewing machines were cranked up by three of the WOM ladies—Jean and Jane made nap blankets for some disadvantaged kindergarteners at local schools. Jean made receiving blankets for preemies at Cone Hospital after receiving an urgent request and Nancy C. made bereavement garments for the Newborns in Need organization.
- Some of the WOM ladies participated with the Fair Ministry through the PMBA.

A special thank you goes to the Senior Moments who provided meals for six of our shut-ins on Thursday, September 21<sup>st</sup>.

On Saturday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, WOM, along with some of our men, will be grilling and serving hot dogs and hamburgers at the Hospice Home in Winston-Salem for the patients' families. Call Jane or Carole for more info how you can help out.
