Another announcement from the bulletin from the Twentieth Sunday after Pentecost, 1949 was instructions about the Rosary said during Mass. Apparently, the congregation was rushing to finish, and the priest (Father Gruss from Doylesburg) wanted to assure the parishioners that there was no need to do so.

The rosary is started immediately after the sermon, and said on through until the bell is rung for the second time, when the priest puts his hands over the Chalice just before the elevation of the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Immediately after the elevation, the rosary is again continued and you will find that it can always be finished before Communion without the least bit of hurrying. Should you be a bit slow in the beginning, I'll wait for you, so don't hurry.
