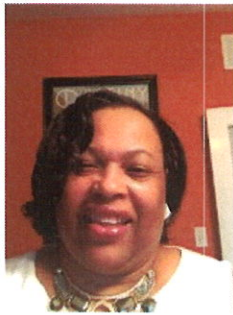
WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP DOT?

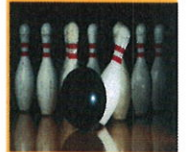
