Notes:

- **NEW - Snaffle Bit** – To compete in this class a horse must be five years and under. (eligible for the following classes: command, games and ranch pleasure)
- **NEW - Hors Concours** - You may ride hors concours in any class. This class is designed for schooling or re-schooling a horse that may require more exposure in the show pen. This is a training opportunity and you will not be judged, nor eligible for points or ribbon. Rider will ride without a number and will pay the applicable class fee.
- **NEW – Fun Games** – Stay tune for a list of fun games that will be held in the light horse ring adjacent to the English ring.
- **NEW – Cowboy Obstacle Course** - Available for your enjoyment during the day, a good learning opportunity for you and your horse. The course is provided by Ottawa Valley Ultimate Horse Club. No official class will be held for the 2020 show season.

Open Division

Any horse/pony and rider combination may compete in any open division class.

Adult Division

Every rider competing in an adult class must be over 18 years of age as of January 1st of the competition year.

Novice Division

Any horse/pony and rider combination which have not shown at any open schooling show, or other recognized breed show, have earned more than 3 first place finishes at a DHRC show in the respective class in that competition year. (if you start as a novice in the year, you will remain a novice for the completion of that year) are eligible to compete in the novice division.

Youth Division

Every rider competing in a youth class must be 18 years of age or under as of January 1st of the competition year.

Lead Line – Not eligible to ride alone in any other class, must be led by a person 16 years or older and must wear an ASTM riding helmet

Walk Trot / Jog Division - Exhibitors cannot enter other classes with a lope / canter
