



How Public Sector Organizations Are Involved in SABER

A public organization must complete the SABER Data Exchange Enrollment to become a member of SABER. The organization's enrollment is reviewed by the SABER Organizing Group.

The public organization must then secure a username and password to enable sharing between the SABER XchangeCore and their application in order for data to be exchanged. As organizations, public and private, make these technology connections, their addition to the SABER community will be announced to all members on the SABERspace.org website.

Public sector organizations – federal, state, local, tribal, region governments – are the consumers of the information provided on SABER. These same groups may become providers of their own emergency information, including transportation status, resource availability, etc. Public sector organizations as providers of information is not a priority for 2014-15 and will be considered by the Organizing Group in the future.
