Our next **YOUTH MASS** will be celebrated on Sunday, May 12, at the 8:15 am Mass. All young people of the parish and their families are invited to attend.

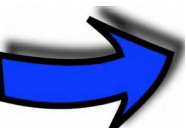


**ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL FOR 2019**

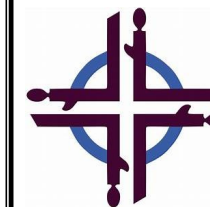
PENTECOST PICNIC
