2. Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting

A motion to accept minutes as read was made by Thomas Bellone Sr. and seconded by Joseph Scapellato. No changes to be made.

Mykola Myronowskyj noted that the August meetings balance sheet was not included in the minutes. The report was not available at the time that the minutes were printed. The balance sheet from the August meeting will be added to these minutes.

3. Treasurers Report & Bills against the Commission

Joseph Scapellato reported:

Major Petroleum had another error on their invoice. Mr. Scapellato contacted their billing department and had the error corrected.

Registration renewal for 43-55 was completed and the new registration card is in the truck. Registration renewal for 43-50 was mailed in.

The Board received the 3rd quarter tax check. The check was processed and deposited.

Petty cash balance in the amount of \$102.00.

4. Old Business

Mykola Myronowskyj reported commented on the following:

Filing of documents that he is able to locate from 2011 and prior. The files that are being archived are being organized, then scanned and then filed.

Mykola Myronowskyj continues to work on the Forest Grove equipment audit.

The MUA's for the surrounding locals that have not been completed yet will begin as soon as possible.

The 2021 financial audit is in progress. Mykola Myronowskyj spoke to Ed Paul and he advised that the audit should be completed in time for the October meeting.

DTA Solutions bookkeeper ordered the new set of checks. The checks were paid by a electronic funds transfer from the Boards account. The checks will be sent to Andrew Bellone Jr's place of business as they will need to be signed for. There was a delay with ordering the checks due to a QuickBooks error. Tamara Ardito was able to save the Board \$73.80 by finding an online coupon for QuickBooks. The new checks were also slightly changes by removing the words Chairman and Treasurer from the signature lines.

Seagrave sent a blank Federal Excise tax exempt form. The form was completed and Mykola Myronowskyj will send it to Seagrave.

The 2023 proposed budget was approved. The 2023 budget will be sent to Ed Paul for review and comment.

Mykola Myronowskyj reported that the rear parking assist not working correctly due to a chip shortage. Mykola spoke to a technician at Hertridge and it was confirmed that the chip will be installed when they are available and will be completed as a recall at some time in the future.



5. New Business

Mykola Myronowskyj reported:

Gloucester County, County wide mutual aid agreement was received. The Board members reviewed the agreement and it was signed. The agreement will be sent back to the Gloucester County Commissioner.

An application was received from Luis Maldonado. He applied as a full member and has provided certificates including FF1. The background check was completed with no issues noted. The Board approved the application and it will be forwarded to the Chief.
