Yard Waste Pick Up Delays

Fairfax County Public Works has posted on their website that they are running behind on Yard Debris pick-up. They suggested you leave your bin at the curb until it is emptied. Unfortunately, the reported delays have been anywhere from one to four days. The pick-ups are sketchy at this point but hopefully, they will be back up to full service soon.

Clubhouse Parking Lot Closure

The clubhouse parking lot will be closed **Tuesday, September 8th** and **Wednesday, September 9th** so that a seal coat, crack filling and re-striping of the parking lot can be performed. If you would like to use the tennis courts or playgrounds, please note that you'll need to arrive on foot or park on the street. If you park on the street, please be respectful of the homes closest to the clubhouse by not blocking driveways or mailboxes. Please do not walk on the pavement while the parking lot is closed as the surface will be wet and need time to dry. The parking lot will be reopened on the evening of Wednesday, September 9th. This work is weather-dependent. If there is a rain delay, notice will be sent by email.



Still Hungry

Food insecurity is still a problem for many people in both Fairfax and Loudoun counties. In May, at the early start of COVID-19, Grace Covenant Church distributed blue bags within many communities to collect food items for those in need. Hiddenbrook was included in their efforts in May and also another collection effort that took place on Saturday, August 29th.

Distribution to families in need has increased from 3,000 to 100,000 and since April 2020, 8,000 pounds of food have been collected and distributed by volunteers. The increase in the call for donations is proof that the need has been consistent and continues to grow as this pandemic, and its aftermath, still have a devastating effect on many.

The blue bags on August 29th were collected by members of the Grace Covenant Church Sterling and coordinated for distribution through the Mobile Hope - Loudoun organization which also covers the Herndon community in their efforts. Even though these food drives are being sponsored by a church, the reality is that this is all about humanity, caring for your fellow man and paying it forward when you can. No matter what faith or creed, this is about people being hungry and those who can help. As conditions have improved for some of us, there are still many who are not as fortunate. Give yourself the gift of helping someone else!
