

**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-0606**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED ZONES FOR  
HIGHWAY 146 NORTH IN THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS;  
PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION  
OF THIS ORDINANCE, EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF AND  
A PENALTY CLAUSE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS:**

Section 1. That the City of Hardin, Texas, is hereby establishing a speed zone on State Highway 146, in the City of Hardin, in Liberty County as shown on the TXDOT Survey Map dated January 27, 2017, attached as Exhibit "A":

Limits are as follows:

- (1) From MP23.301 going South to MP 24.038 (.737 miles) shall be reduced to 45 mph.
- (2) From MP24.038 to MP 24.669 (.631 miles) shall be reduced to 55 mph.
- (3) Total length of proposed speed reduction and limit is 1.368 miles.

Section 2. That the City of Hardin, Texas, is hereby amended by establishing the following speed control in the School Zone as shown on the TXDOT Survey Map dated January 27, 2017:

Section 3. The Caption of this ordinance shall be published one (1) time in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Hardin, Texas and shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication, and after all necessary signs have been installed.


Section 4. This Ordinance establishing the reduction of speed for the City of Hardin, Texas, is in addition to the School Zone/Speed Zone Ordinance # 2016-1207 which remains in effect.

Section 5. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
