

Remember that big Caldron that has been stored in/near the target shack for the past few years? It was first used 49 years ago at the first and/or second rendezvous, where everyone brought a large can of Chili to be opened and poured into the Caldron and stirred over the Council Fire.

The caldron has been restored. It was pressure washed, scrubbed, sanitized, and seasoned for use at our 49th annual Horse Ridge Rendezvous.

We're going to provide a traditional meal of Cornbread and Chili. **Pretty Flinchy** will be accepting donated Large Cans of Chili from club members and attendees for a Chili feed Friday evening around the council fire at ± 6:00pm.

For those who can, bring a pan or Dutch

oven of Combread to complete the feast.
We'll also be needing some toppers:
shredded cheese, chopped onions, etc.
Also butter or honey for the Combread

Dutch Oven Cornbread w/Peppers

Whisk together: 1 cup milk, 1 cube melted unsalted butter, and 1 beaten egg. Whisk together: 1 cup flour, 1 cup cornmeal, 3 tbsp sugar, 1-1/4 tsp chili powder, and 1 tsp. salt and add to batter. Add 1 cup finely diced red, green, and finely diced jalapeno peppers to the mix and put into Dutch oven. Bake at 400°F until toothpick comes out clean. 20—24 briquettes.


Dutch Oven Sourdough Cornbread

Mix; 1 cup sourdough starter, 2 cups cornmeal (enough to make a batter), 1-1/2 cups milk, 2 Tbsp sugar, and 2 beaten eggs and stir thoroughly in a large bowl. Stir in: 1/4 cup butter or fat (melted and stil warm), 2 pinches each of salt, and baking soda. Turn into a greased 14inch Dutch oven over 15-20 coals and place 15-20 coals on the lid. Bake 25-30 minutes.
