We will be restructuring our ECLC, PreK and Kindergarten over the next few months. Starting in January, PreK will be combined with our Kindergarten class full time. 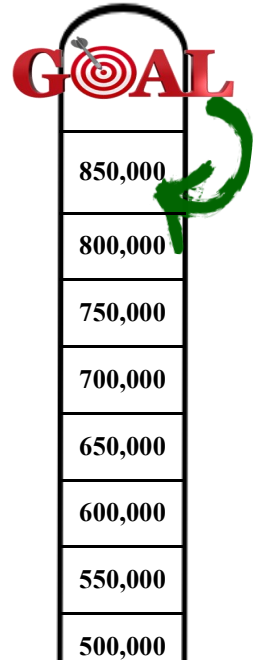
