From the Pastor's Office...

Deacon Dan Kohler was ordained to the Permanent Diaconate on August 14, 2022. It was a day that many of us will not forget. Once the ordination was over each new deacon whether Transitional or Permanent receives his official appointment from our Bishop. A "Transitional" Deacon is a deacon for about six months to a year, then God willing they are ordained a priest. In the summer, they are assigned to a parish in their diocese to share the assigned responsibilities of the deacon. The Transitional Deacon will finish his appointment while in the seminary at his teaching parish. The Permanent Deacon, like Deacon Dan Kohler, also receives his appointment from our Bishop and lives out the same responsibilities of the transitional deacon.

I am so happy to share this announcement with all our parishes. Deacon Dan Kohler has been appointed by Bishop James Powers "to serve as Deacon to the following Parishes: Immaculate Conception, Hammond and St. Bridget, River Falls, already effective on ordination date of August 14, 2022."

Deacon Dan and I will be meeting to determine how often he will be serving in both places. Once his schedule is in place, Deacon Dan will share his schedule and his ministry as deacon with all of you. In the next few weeks, Dan will be serving Mass here in River Falls. Please make him feel as welcome as you made me and Fr. Anil feel.

Deacon Dan, Congratulations and welcome to the River Falls cluster. We look forward to many years of service with you at Mass and beyond.—Fr. Joe Stefancin
