The season of Lent has begun so I want to mention to you some events that will be happening during this time:


- 1 Catholic Men's Fellowship will be meeting on Saturday March 16 at 8 a.m. (St. Joseph Knights of Columbus basement). I will continue with the Symbolon series and be showing Episode 18- "A Love that Lasts: God's Plan for Sexuality." All men are welcome to this opportunity to add something in your life during this Lenten season. Sharing and discussing our faith goes a long way to helping us be the men that God wants us to be.
- 2 Fish Fry Friday at St. Joseph along with Stations of the Cross at both parishes. Bring you family and your friends to some great food and fellowship. If you have never been to a Fish Fry, then you are missing something that will be delicious and satisfying. After, the Fish Fry you can be fed spiritually with the Stations of the Cross. I will be leading it at St. Joseph and Deacon Steve Vogt will be leading it at Sacred Heart. To reflect on all that Jesus suffered for the salvation of our souls is not something to be forgotten. Every Catholic should attend at least one Stations of the Cross during the season of Lent.
- 3 There will be a change in the Mass schedule on Tuesday March 19- The Solemnity of St. Joseph- Husband of Mary. There will be NO Mass at Sacred Heart this day. There will be two Masses at St. Joseph that day. There will be a morning Mass at St. Joseph at 10:30 a.m. because St. Joseph Galion school will join St. Joseph Crestline school in celebrating the feast day of their patron. There will also be a Mass at St. Joseph at 6:30 p.m. that day for the parish to celebrate its patronal feast day. Thanks for your understanding with this change in the Mass schedule.
- There will be no Bible Study on March 20. It is rescheduled for Wednesday April 17. Followed by another Bible Study class a week later April 24. Thanks for your understanding with this schedule change.
- 5 There will be an evening Holy Hour for Catholic Education on Wednesday April 3 at 7 p.m. at St. Joseph. Teachers from both schools will be there to pray for our schools and all Catholic schools around the world. This is certainly something special to add to your Lenten activities.
- 6 Wednesday April 10 will be a Day of Grace in which I will be in both parish confessionals throughout the day. After I have finished confessions, I will have a One- Hour Retreat. The theme will be- "The Good Thief." It will be an hour of recorded songs, stories, scripture and reflection. Yes, we are all busy, but certainly you can make a One-Hour retreat to help focus your faith on what is important!
- 7 This year Sacred Heart Parish will host the Holy Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday- Easter Vigil. Cierra Roberts, Amanda Crafton, Stephanie Schlitz and Lindsay Mills should be coming into full communion in the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil Mass so please keep them in your prayers!
