Hopefully everyone is restocking their freezers for our final sale of Little Caesars! **Orders and money need to be turned in by Thursday, February 28<sup>th</sup>.** I am only accepting **ONE CHECK or MONEY ORDER** per order made out to Studio 7 School of Dance. If this is a problem, please let me know. Please note: You need to fill in the order forms completely (tally the orders at the bottom, figure out the totals sales, and make sure your name is on the order forms.) **Delivery will be Tuesday, March 19<sup>th</sup> from 4:00-6:00 pm** at the dance studio. Regular 9-10 and HHC will not meet. All other classes will meet.

Just a reminder, fundraisers are *not* mandatory and the profit may go toward tuition, merchandise, show expenses, and tight and bodysuit orders (amounts vary). This is a great way to reduce costs leading up to show time. ALL profit must be used by the end of the current 2018-2019 dance season as it does not carry over to next year.

## MAPLE FESTIVAL PARADE-

The festival parade is on Saturday, April 6<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm. (Dancers are asked to be at the float site a little after 12:00 pm. More info will be sent at a closer date). The Thursday 7:30 Pom class, Tuesday 6:30 drill class, and Company dancers will be dancing in the parade. Pom/Drill dancers will be wearing black pom shoes, black pants, and a Studio 7 sweatshirt or jacket (red, black, or white- all with layers underneath if needed) and Company dancers will be wearing their company jackets, black pants, and tennis shoes. **If your dancer is interested in riding on the studio's float, please let me know ASAP.** I would like all dancers to wear Studio 7 merchandise in the parade. If you have not purchased anything, you may wear red/black/yellow/white. As soon as I find out our line-up location and time, I will pass that on to those participating. \* **Dancers will need to meet me outside the park entrance no later than 1:45 pm.** Performance time is 2:00-2:45 (or until we are done dancing). Due to unknown weather conditions, please have your dancer dressed in layers that can be removed. This way they stay warm until it's their time to perform. Dancers are asked to wear any Studio 7 gear if you have and plain black pants (sweatpants, exercise pants, etc.) (merchandise orders will be in before the Festival Park performance). If you don't have any merchandise, please wear red/black/yellow or white. *Dancers will have free admission into Festival Park; however, everyone going into the park to watch the dancers will have to pay a regular park admission cost.* Several times we have had to cancel due to poor weather conditions. If the weather is looking bad again, please keep checking your email if it becomes unsafe to be dancing outside. Fingers crossed a later performance this date will mean a nice day to dance! If your dancer's class was not chosen to perform, please try to come and support Studio 7 and the Maple Festival anyway!
