February Reflection

1 Corinthians 12:27 "Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it."

It is a powerful thing to be a part of a family isn't it? To be a part of a family means that someone always has your back. One of my dad's favorite stories from his youth was when his brother protected him from some boys who wanted to beat him up. My dad well deserved the beating he was going to get from these boys, but just as they were about to catch him, his brother showed up, and said, "No one beats him up except for me." What a blessing it is to be a part of a family.

Friends this past month has been one of the hardest of my life. From my mother being hospitalized and not sure if she would even make it out of the ICU, to having to put my first dog, Hershey down, it has felt at times like I was in a country song. Life can be like that though. I know I am not the first person who has ever gone through something like this, and I am confident that I won't be the last. I'm willing to bet that for each and every one of us, there have been times in life when we have burdens that seem to be almost too much to bear.

I am sure that we have all heard the old adage, "God doesn't give you more than you can bear," but at times it seems that God overestimates our own strength. There is inherent within life a very difficult truth: hard times come, there are moments when it seems you can't get on your feet, times when the storms of life rage and it feels as if you can't get your head above water. And if you have found yourself in a moment like this, you might ask yourself, "How can I get through this moment?"

I'll tell you what this past month has shown me; simply you can't do it alone. When life is perilous, when the journey is difficult, we can't make it on our own. We need the love and support of others, we need the comfort of a family, we need others to help us bear the burdens we hold. That's why I'm so thankful for the people of First Methodist Cherryville, that's why I am so thankful for you, because I will tell you, without your love, your support, and most importantly your prayers, I don't what I or my family would have done.

You may have noticed when someone joins the church I always tell them the same thing. "I've got good news for you and bad news, the good news is that our joys are now your joys. The bad news is our problems are now your problems." I always say it a bit tongue in cheek, but I have felt you lifting burdens for me. When Paul wrote to the church in Corinth they were struggling with many different things, too many to list in this reflection in fact, but there is one salient point that Paul wanted to drive home, "as the church you are in this together."

That's why I believe this image of the body of Christ works so well for how we understand our relationship to one another and our relationship that we share with the church. It is up to us, to look out for one another, it is up to us to become that family which prays with and prays for one another. If you have ever found yourself in a time like I have recently you know just how profound that prayer is.

Indeed we as First UMC Cherryville are the body of Christ, it is our job to be there for one another, to

have each other's backs, and to encourage one another in truth and in love. May we show Cherryville the transformative power of family, as we strive to walk closer with Christ and closer with one another.
