

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

State of Minnesota, County of Wabasha ss:

ON THIS 26 day of February, A. D. 1891 personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the County and State aforesaid, Archibald Ross aged 56 years, of Red Wing P.O. County of Goodhue State of Minnesota, who, being duly

sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Milwaukee Pension Agency at the rate of Fourteen dollars per month, Certificate No. 283457, by reason of disability from Rheumatism and Resulting Disease of his Heart (Here name the disability for which pension was granted.)

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of increase in his disability and that his present rate of Pension being unjustly low and not commensurate with his degree of disability by reason of Rheumatism Resulting in Disease of his heart and the result
