Brethren all,



This rare and unique watch is finely engraved with Masonic imagery and symbols. The case of this watch is marked "Hiram Watch Inc., 14K, No. 123". President Warren G. Harding, a Freemason, also carried an identical Hiram Watch, his case number being marked as No. 145.
