Rules & Guidelines of Acushnet FC

- · Cost
 - · Players are responsible to pay the following registration fees to play for AFC:
 - \$50 Fall Travel
 - \$80 Spring Travel
 - Players are responsible for the following uniform cost:
 - \$35 Fall Travel Uniform (Xara)
 - \$80 Spring Travel Uniform (Adidas)
- Fundraising
 - · All fundraising must be approved by the AYSA Board of directors.
 - Each team will now be limited to 3 Fundraisers per year with a specific cause. Unless the fundraiser is for a
 destination trip for the entire team.
 - Fundraising money is to be used on the players of that specific team only.
 - Fundraising money can be used to pay for any apparel, tournaments, indoor soccer, team parties, or field rentals.
 However you cannot use it to pay for any fall or spring registrations or uniforms.
 - All players must be offered the specific cause in order for the fundraising money to be used. As well as Board
 approval for the cause.
- Team Placement
 - · Travel soccer is grade based. So all players will be placed accordingly.
 - When only one team exist in a division, the team must have tryouts every season to try and get the best team
 possible or until their are enough players for two teams.
 - Any player not paid at least 2 weeks after the deadline of payment due will be removed from the team and may not return to any AYSA or AFC activities until paid in full.
 - Any player not from the town of Acushnet must obtain a waiver from the city /town that they reside in order to play.
 - No player that plays for any other town soccer program will be allowed to play for AFC. A player may play club
 and town soccer, but not town and town.
- AFC is not a pay and play team, however if you feel as though your child is not playing at all and it becomes an
 issue. We ask that you please inform the travel coordinator and it will be handled.
