What has the Association been up to....?

- A group of volunteers applied and received a grant for \$1000 to go towards spraying for invasive species in our lake.
- Volunteers sold pull tabs at the Chisago county fair and made over \$1600 in a weekend to use for lake improvement.
- During the weekend of the Isanti County fair volunteers from the lake association worked at the fair selling and taking tickets to raise money for lake improvement.
- This spring 2.9 acres of the Northeast corner of Big Goose were sprayed for weeds.
- Organized a group discount for lake shore homeowners who wanted to have their shore lines sprayed for weeds.
- Held a fishing contest in June. Lots of prizes were award and raised some money for the association. We had 46 adults and 15 kids participate.
- A parade was organized on the 4th of July. 23 boats and a jetski took part in the parade around Big Goose.
