November 2017 Meeting Dates

**Meetings are at the Clover Arts Center (formerly Baptist Temple)
1101 Clover St., Brighton.**

Unless there are holiday conflicts, our regular meetings will be on the first and third Mondays of the month. This month's meetings will be Nov. 6th and Nov.20th.

The first meeting will be the competition, with the following categories: digital, monochrome, large color and small color. Announcements are at **7:00** with competition starting at **7:15**. Late submissions (after 7:00) will not be eligible for competition. *Dues must have been paid prior to the meeting so that you are on the membership list in order to compete.* The second meeting will be an educational program that will start at 7:30. There will be a Board meeting starting at 6:30 p.m. – All members are welcome to sit in.

November 20 Program Meeting: Small Group Critiques

Members will meet at tables in small groups to discuss images brought in by those at the table. There will be a member/facilitator at each table who will lead the discussion. Plan to bring four or five images you'd like suggestions for. Images may be matted or just prints. Images should be no smaller than 8X10 but can be larger. Hopefully there will be time to shift to different table groupings so everyone will receive a greater amount of feedback on their images.

Digital Competition Deadline and Submission Info

The deadline for submission of images for the digital competition is midnight on the Monday preceding the competition day (Oct 30th this month). Following the submission rule, send no more than 2 images in this category to: CameraRochesterDCS@gmail.com. The images should be in jpeg format and resized to 1920 in the longest dimension. Please name image files with your name and the title (Your Name – Title of Image.jpg). Note the single space on either side of the dash. Any extraneous information will become part of the title or author. Please also put the month in the subject of the email (Images for Month).

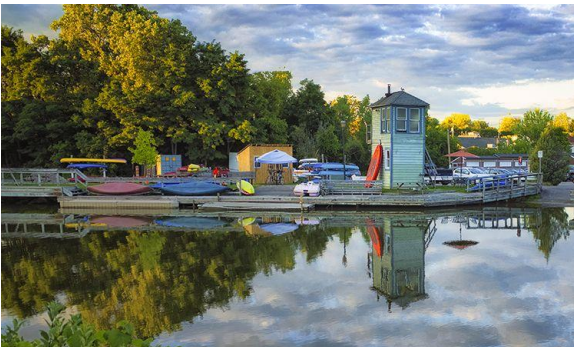

Episcopal Home Holiday Show Information

The title of the show is "Visions For The Season". Keep that in mind when selecting an image to enter. Also, consider that people will be looking for gifts to purchase at this time of year.

The Gallery has 24 hangers similar to those at the Clover Center. If 24 members submit images, each person may enter one large image 16X20 or larger, or two smaller images 8X10. There is also a glass case for photo creations that can't be hung on the wall. Contact Michelle if you want to put something in the case. The fee to enter images is \$10 to cover the reception food and beverages. The Gallery will take a 10% commission from any sales which the artist will pay directly to the Gallery.

We will need volunteers for a variety of tasks. Please consider how you might be able to help. We will pass a sign-up sheet at the club meetings leading up to the show. Areas where we'll need help are: registration, hanging the show and taking down the show.

Sales: The sale price of the image will be listed in the program and on the title cards.

Eligibility: You must be a current, paid up member of Camera Rochester.

Procedure: Frames must be black or dark brown gallery appropriate and have a wire on the back for hanging.
Minimum framed size is 8X10; maximum size 24". Mats should be white, black or gray.
Attach the entry tag (from next page) to the back upper left hand corner of each image.
