

A cursory analysis of the statistical data from this report should be demonstrative of the quality of performance of this agency in realizing the contractual obligations and the overall achievement of the goals and objectives of this Agency and the Toll Road Division.

A total of 320 man-hours was scheduled; 240 man-hours were actual dedicated to patrol functions. hours were exhausted on vacation time, workers compensatory, and sick leave. 1,208 total miles were driven and the shift responded to 367 total service calls. The shift issued 13 traffic warnings, made 1 arrests and handled 15 enforcement service-related calls. The average productivity ratio for this month for this shift is 3.7


Patrol Activity by Braeburn Valley Personnel:
