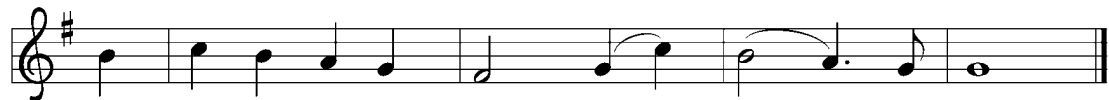

our judge and our hope.

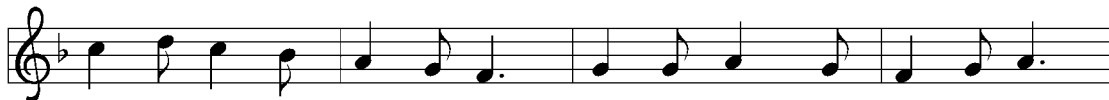
