We will be open on President's Day (Monday, February 17th), regular hours, for students who normally attend on Mondays, for DAYCARE only. However, for staffing purposes, we do ask that you let the office know whether your child will or will not attend, by signing up on the Holiday Survey that will be posted in the foyer near the fish tank during the week of January 27th. If you have someone else do the drop off/pick up for you child(ren), you can send the school an email letting us know if you need your child to attend or not. To guarantee that we will have enough staff members on campus, students **MUST** be signed up in order to attend. The last day to sign up will be Friday, February 7th.

Priority Registration for Learning Tree families and their siblings will take place March 2nd, 3rd, and 4th. Registration instructions and new tuition rates (effective June 15, 2020) will be emailed out mid-January. Registration applications will be emailed out to you at the end of February. You will need to print your applications, fill them out and submit them to the office during the Priority Registration time frame.

During our Children Around the World Unit, we will celebrate different countries and their traditions. On Tuesday, March 3rd, we will celebrate Japanese Girls' Day. This is a special day when girls can bring in their favorite doll to be displayed in the Indoor Room. The children will be having a special snack on the yard, so watch for sign-ups for donations.
