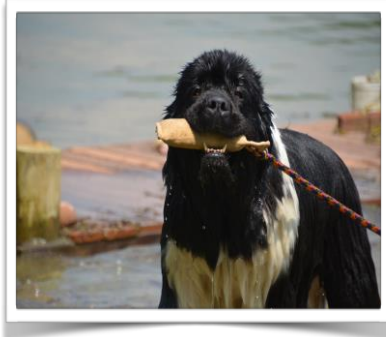

Purpose of the Water Test

NCA Water Tests are a series of exercises designed to develop and demonstrate the abilities of purebred Newfoundland dogs in an aquatic environment. NCA water tests demonstrate natural ability and skills acquired through training, and emphasize teamwork between dog and handler in simulated work and rescue situations. The ideal working relationship is a balance of controlled performance and natural independence. Dogs should display not only efficiency in accomplishing their tasks, but also willingness and enjoyment in their work.



The Test Site

High Falls County Park is located in Seneca SC. The park is on the western shore of Lake Keowee, in Oconee County. An abundance of shore line makes this park an ideal setting. The water is very clear and together with a solid packed bottom, you should see virtually no mud, or silt disruption during the Underwater Retrieve. The grade below the water drops off gradually and the dogs will be swimming

within the required 20 feet. The water, out from the beach area, is classified as a 'No Wake Zone.' Two clusters of pine trees offer natural shade. Entrants are encouraged to bring tarps for additional shade. Electricity is available as well as drinking water. A very large pavilion will be available, with a restroom inside. A restroom near the entrance of the park provides a changing room and shower facilities.

Rules and Regulations - Exhibitors Note

This Water Test is sanctioned by the Working Dog Committee (WDC) of the Newfoundland Club of American and sponsored by the Southeastern Newfoundland Club and will follow the NCA's Water Test Regulations copyrighted in 1999 and updated in January 2017. Entrants are responsible for obtaining and reading the regulations governing NCA Water Tests. A copy of the official Water Test Regulations may be found on-line at www.newfdogclub.org or by contacting the Working Dog Committee Publications Secretary, Dwight Gorsuch, 5282 Burris Road, Rock Hall, MD 21661.

Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his/her own water test equipment, including a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device and suitable foot protection to be worn in the water.

NCA Aggression Policy

Any dog that, in the opinion of the Event Committee, attacks a person or a dog at an NCA working event, resulting in an injury, and is believed by that Event Committee to present a hazard to persons or other dogs, shall be disqualified. When the dog is disqualified by the Event Committee pursuant to this section, a report shall be filed with the NCA Board. The disqualified dog may not again compete at any NCA working event, nor be on the grounds of an NCA working event unless and until, following application for reinstatement by the owner to the NCA Board, the owner receives official notification in writing from the NCA Board that the dog's eligibility has been reinstated.

SENC Safety Policy

- Dogs must be crated or on leash at all times.
- When on leash, the length of the leash must not exceed six feet and may not be a retractable leash.
- When on leash, dogs must be under control at all times.
- Dogs showing uncontrolled, or aggressive behavior, will be asked by the event chair, a board member, or other official to leave the site promptly or to be crated for the duration of the event.
- Failure to meet these conditions may result in a disciplinary hearing. There will be occasions when the dog will be allowed off lead when approved by the chairman.

Bitches in Season or with Ovarian Sparing Spay

Bitches in season or ovarian sparing spay will not be allowed on the test site until just prior to being judged, which will be after all other dogs are tested. When not being tested, these bitches must be contained in a designated area away from the official test areas. If you are entering a bitch, do you anticipate she might be in season? As a courtesy, please inform the test secretary prior to September 19, 2017.

Un-entered Dogs

Spectators, as well as un-entered dogs are welcome at the SENC Water Test. However, un-entered dogs will not be permitted near the test site area. As a courtesy to our exhibitors, we ask that all dogs be kept quiet, on leash or crated. The appointed Safety Officer is responsible for ensuring that all un-entered dogs are kept outside and away from the designated test area.

All Breed Test - THIS IS NOT AN NCA EVENT

The Southeastern Newfoundland Club invites all dogs to participate in a separate water test to be held on Friday afternoon, Sept 29th, 2017. Neither the Southeastern Newfoundland Club nor the Newfoundland Club of America will award titles. Any dog successfully completing all exercises at any level will be issued a certificate of completion by the Southeastern Newfoundland Club which the owners can submit to their parent clubs for recognition.

Directions to the Site

From the Quality Inn:

- Turn right at street light at Fatz's Restaurant onto US123 (Sandifer Blvd).
- Go to 3rd light and turn left on SC28 (Blue Ridge Blvd).
- Turn right at light on SC188 and continue on SC188 until it dead ends at SC183 (Pickens Hwy).
- Turn right on SC183 Pickens Hwy. Go 1.7 miles.
- Turn right on High Falls Rd. Go about 1.1 miles. Arrive at High Falls County Park. (Travel time approx. 25-30 minutes)

From Interstate 85 from Charlotte, NC:

- Take exit 19B onto US76 West toward Clemson - go 22.5 miles.
- US76 West becomes Clemson Blvd. - go 5.2 miles.
- Turn right on Rochester Hwy - go 8.7 miles.
- Continue on SC183 (Pickens Hwy) - go 1.9 miles.
- Turn left on High Falls Rd - go 1.1 miles into High Falls Co Park.

From Interstate 85 from Atlanta, GA:

- Take exit #1 toward Walhalla - go 0.6 miles.
- Turn left on SC-11 - go 22.3 miles.
- Turn right on SC-24 (Country Junction Rd) - go 2.2 miles.
- Turn right on SC-183 (Pickens Hwy) - go 3.2 miles.
- Turn right on High Falls Rd - go 1.1 miles into High Falls County Park.

September 29, 2017

There are **21 entrant allotted spots**

WRDX -Total of 6 entrants.

If WRDX test doesn't fill, left over spots will be filled with WD WRD entries.

All Breed

The Friday All Breed Test is limited to 5 dogs.

September 30, 2017

There are **25 entrant spots** allotted to be filled with WD & WRD. If space allows, WRD requalifiers will be given the balance after all WD and WRD entries are processed.

October 1st, 2017

There are **25 entrant spots**

WRDX -Total of 6 entrants.

19 entries of WD & WRD will be accepted. If space allows, WRD requals will be given the balance after all WD, WRD, WRDX entries are processed.

Entry fee is \$45.00 for each dog each day. Entries can be accepted by U.S. Postal Service and must be postmarked no earlier than August 14th, 2017 for NCA members. Any entries received with a postmark prior to August 14th, 2017 will be returned to sender. Non-NCA members must be postmarked no earlier than August 24th, 2017.



Priority will be given to entrants who have not earned titles in the Division entered. Foreign entries must show a verifiable date of mailing. All entries must be submitted on entry form, **and must include a copy of the dog's current AKC, ILP/PAL or foreign registration**, & appropriate fee.

Entries will close at the home of the Test Secretary at **6:00 pm EST on September 1st, 2017**.

After that date, entries cannot be accepted, canceled/refunded, altered, or substituted. Entries will be made according to postmark date. In the event the number of entries with the same postmark date received exceeds the limit, vacancies will be filled and alternates will be determined by a random drawing. Entries received after the entry limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate list in order of postmark. Alternates will be notified immediately should an opening occur. As space permits, re-qualifiers are welcomed. The SENC will abide by the most recent policy on Accepting and Assigning Entries and Alternates and Refunds as stated in the Newfoundland Water Dog, Water Rescue Dog, and Water Rescue Dog Excellent Regulations as updated January 2017.

Transfer of Entry from WD to WRD Division or WRD To WRDX

Per the NCA Water Test Regulations, if a dog entered in WD has passed a WD test after the closing date for entries, the entry may be transferred from the WD to the WRD Division. Dogs who earn a WRD title in a subsequent water test, and who are entered in WRD at tests whose entries have closed, may transfer their entry from the WRD to WRDX tests. To transfer the entry, the handler must submit to the Water Test Secretary a signed statement listing the name of the dog, the date and location of the Water Test passed, the judges' names, and the name and address of the owners. A change of entry from WD to WRD or WRD to WRDX must be received by Test Secretary by 6:00 pm the night before the test.

Re-Qualifiers for WRD

Entrants for re-qualifiers will be accepted only if the entry limit is not reached. Dogs that qualify in WRD at a previous test may stay in as Requalifiers, but will be moved to the alternate list (if any). Acceptance into the test(s) will then be based on the postmark of the original entry.

Post Entries

Dogs that successfully fulfill the requirements for a Junior Division Water Dog title at a test may post-entered into the Senior Division and will be tested at the conclusion of Senior Division judging. The handler will be allowed to test his/her dog until it fails an exercise. An additional post-entry fee of \$15.00 must be given to the test secretary at the site at the completion of the Junior Division.

Practice Time

The Test Site will be available for practice on Thursday, Sept 28 from 2 PM until 5 PM with a boat. On Friday, Sept 29, and Saturday, Sept 30 from the conclusion of all testing. Stewards and boat will not be available.

Awards

- **Each entrant** will receive a welcome gift bag. Each qualifier will receive a unique trophy selected by the Water Test Committee.
- **Oldest Qualifying or Requalifying** Newfoundland Water Dog, Water Rescue Dog or Water Rescue Dog Excellent Over the Age of 7 Years. In memory of VN Bronze GCH Kloofbear Over the Rainbow TimberKnoll (Ellie) CD WRD 4 WRDX DD TDD CGC ROM, Benita Edds and Patti Sutherland, offer a \$25 gift certificate for the oldest qualifying or requalifying Water Dog, Water Rescue Dog, or Water Rescue Dog Excellent over the age of 7 years on Sunday to encourage continued participation in water work after receiving a title and allowing older Newfoundlands to continue doing what they love.
- **Mary Ann Barnhill Memorial Award**
SENC will award and present each day (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) after the Newfoundland Club of America test to the handler/dog team which, in the opinion of the judges exemplifies the handler and dog working as a team. Mary Ann expressed gentleness yet having the expectation of the dog's performance. The handler/dog team need not pass the test to receive an award.
