Resumption of Overseas Voting Registration

The Philippine Consulate General in Vancouver is pleased to announce the start of the Overseas Voting Registration period for the 2022 Presidential Elections, beginning Monday, 16 December 2019.

All Filipino citizens in British Columbia, the Yukon and the Northwest Territories, who are at least 18 years of age on 9 May 2022, may apply for registration or certification as Overseas Voter either at the Consulate or at any of its outreach missions conducted between 16 December 2019 and 21 September 2021 (the registration period).

Applicants are to personally appear for biometrics data capturing and to submit their application form along with their original and photocopy of proof of Philippine citizenship (valid Philippine passport or dual citizenship identification certificate).

The Consulate encourages everyone who has not yet registered as an Overseas Voter to do so during this registration period. Only approved registered Overseas Voters may participate in the 2022 Presidential Elections.

Those who are already registered Overseas Voters are encouraged to check the list of deactivated voters at the link below to ensure that you are still active voter.
