The War On Drugs

This is a special issue of THE INTELLIGENCE NEWSLETTER. The entire issue will be devoted to a plan of action whereby the American citizen can assume a leadership role in a genuine effort to eliminate heroin and opium in the United States. Apologies are in order for those who were looking forward to the **Lessons In History**. It was stated in the last issue that we would discuss the American Revolution in this issue. However, that subject will have to wait until the next issue because of the extreme urgency of the information and request for action included herein.

If an honest poll were to be taken of the American people's opinion of the administration's "War On Drugs", probably not more than ten percent would be naive enough to believe that the government's current plan of action is intended to work. One can almost be certain that no one in Washington believes it!

The September-October, 1988 issue of this newsletter discussed the difference between Bush and Dukakis. It was concluded that neither were suitable to be president. Bush's relationship to the Plutocratic, Elite-Capitalist, Zionist goals for an authoritarian (militant) world order controlled by the international money barons was discussed. Included in their efforts going back to the days of Oliver Cromwell was a discussion on the Chinese Opium War in the 1800s. That war was deliberately instigated by Plutocratic England (using the British East Indies Company) by the forced admission of opium into China.

The Chinese Opium War continues to this day! Only now it is cocaine from Columbia and heroin and opium from the Golden Triangle of Burma, Thailand and Laos. Make no mistake about it. It is not a war to STOP the importation of drugs into this country (as well as the other Western Christian countries). It is a war against us, to destroy our will to resist, and to destroy Christianity. Also, they make billions upon billions of dollars in profit while they are doing it!

Further, this "Luciferian" war against us here in our beloved nation, is a perfect example of Hegellian dialectics in action. First, the government opened the flood-gates for immigration into our country, by third and fourth world peoples, most of whom have a totally different set of customs, morals and mores. This includes the appetite for drugs. Then, the government allowed the drugs to be imported without any really, meaningful resistance. Then, in the 1960s and 1970s, the government allowed the National Education Association (NEA) and the nation's school system to teach our young children about the evils of drugs through the Stamp Out Stupidity (SOS) program. Teachers reported that the program had the opposite effect. Young children had "that look" in their eyes while they watched films on how to roll a marijuana cigarette and how to sniff cocaine. Then came Nancy's "Just Say No" campaign. But, by that time, the country was hooked on drugs.

That was the thesis of the dialectics. To make the dialectics work, there has to be the antithesis. So what did the government do? It became very active in a "war against drugs."

It claimed to increase Coast Guard activities while in actuality it decreased its budget. It put up tethered radar balloons along the Mexican border to detect low flying aircraft. These are reported not to be working much of the time. It opened the El Paso (Texas) Intelligence Center (EPIC), reportedly to gather and file intelligence on drug pushers. Of course, information on citizens in general is necessary in order to sort out the drug dealers!

Then it really "declared war on drugs." Almost immediately, the "talking heads" on TV started their editorials stating that "to 'declare war', the country has to be ready to give up something, just like we did without things during WWII." To what were they referring? To our Constitutional and God-ordained freedoms and liberty, of course. Our freedom to travel without checkpoints. Our freedom from search without probable cause. Our freedom of assembly. Our freedom to own and freely transport weapons, especially certain so-called "assault weapons." (The argument, of course, is to keep these weapons out of the hands of the drug cartels and those with demented minds).

All the while this scam of a "declared war on drugs" is being conducted, the really "big boys" go on making billions of dollars profit and, we as a Christian nation, come that much closer to total annihilation. It is a continuation of the Chinese Opium War started in the 1800s.

The Light At The End Of The Tunnel. There is a way to stop this assault on our Christian way of life. It would be so simple if we could just fire every person in all three branches of government; the Judicial, the Legislative, and the Executive. But it is not that simple. The problem is the fourth branch of government, the News Media. This "branch" of government is capitalized intentionally because it is at least on an equal plane of importance with the other three.

For us to write "letters to the editors" and to write to our congressmen is, of course, the "American way." In the case of a problem as big and political as the drug problem, the news media simply will not push it like they would if it were a debate over the Martin Luther King holiday or the Bernard Getz fiasco. The major news media is totally controlled.

To get the American people to understand the magnitude of the problem, they must be informed at the grass roots level. The major news media doesn't own or control many of the small-town weekly or daily newspapers, the cable TV outlets, and the small-town independent radio stations. These businesses do not owe allegiance to the "masters" at the major news media level.

Suppose that a "blitzkrieg" offense were conducted to inform the American people at the grass roots level through the small town newspapers, radio stations, cable TV outlets and newsletters. Would the American people become incensed enough to DEMAND that Changes be made in the government itself?

We will know the answer to this searching question in the very near future! A small group of very dedicated leaders in Christianity have banded together under the leadership of Col. James "Bo" Gritz and under the Sovereignty of Jesus Christ, the King of Kings, to inform grass roots America of this criminal behaviour. A massive mailing has been completed to most every newspaper, radio station, TV (including cable outlets) and conservative newsletter in the United States. That's a bunch! Nearly 25,000 of them! The *Daily News Digest* (9/13/89) presented the following article, written by Brian Quigg who was a staff investigator on the House Subcommittee Investigating the Intelligence Community in the wake of President Nixon's resignation. He is a dedicated, trained researcher. His views must not be taken lightly.

"After researching the 'big picture' for 15 years, I would like to offer this analysis which I believe penetrates not only our government's phony 'war on drugs' but the fraud of the international communist conspiracy as well."

"This article presumes that the readers are acquainted with the role Lt. Colonel James Bo Gritz has played in exposing Theodore Shackley, formerly #2 man at CIA as one of the world's largest purchasers of Golden Triangle heroin. I produced and edited the 2 hour VHS video of this episode, *The Heroin Highway*, which is available c/o Daily News Digest for \$21.95."

"When Theodore Shackley became CIA station chief in Miami in 1962 he inherited the CIA's 'executive action' program. 'Executive action' is the CIA's euphemism for the assassination of foreign leaders. In 1975 the Church committee investigated this matter and identified the riflemen assigned to Shackley in this program. To identify the more recent assignments of these gunmen is to indicate the ongoing importance of this assassins group in U.S. foreign policy. Chi Chi Quintero was the base commander of the Contra air base, Santa Elena, in Costa Rica and Felix Rodreguez was base commander of the Ilapango resupply base in Honduras. Frank Sturgis and Rolando Martinez, two other executive action gunman in Shackley's program, along with their supervisor, E. Howard Hunt, were Nixon 'plumbers' caught burglarizing the Watergate Hotel. Theodore Shackley and his deputy,

Tom Clines, were the higher ups of the Iran/Contra scandal-Shackley handling the Iran arms side and Clines the Contra end."

NEWS RELEASE

Colonel James "Bo" Gritz, America's most decorated Green Beret commander of the Vietnam War and real-life role model for the "Rambo" movie series, recently returned from the Shan province of Burma where he had been searching for prisoners of war (POW's). Although he did not return with any POW's, he did bring back evidence of high U. S. government corruption in the drug trade and also a signed and sealed offer from General Khun Sa to stop the annual export of 2,200 metric tons of heroin.

General Khun Sa is the drug overlord of the Golden Triangle in Southeast Asia which produces 90% of the world's heroin and opium. The General's proposal, contained in a four page document, which Colonel Gritz has sent to all radio stations and newspapers in America, entails the elimination of the poppy fields in the Golden Triangle. This in return for some minimal U. S. foreign aid in the establishment of a substitute crop for the eight million Shan people. With evidence of high government corruption in the drug trade, Colonel Gritz fears Khun Sa's offer is being ignored and stonewalled. To prevent this and what the Colonel says could be another NO-WIN-WAR called the War on Drugs, he and other citizens have formed The Center For Action, 711 Yucca Street, Boulder City, Nevada 89005 (phone 1-800-293-3900).

Colonel Bo Gritz first met Khun Sa in 1986 while on a White House sanctioned mission to verify the presence of U. S. POW's in the Golden Triangle. The Colonel says he did verify that POW's were still being held in Laos and Vietnam, but claims his efforts to bring some out and home were thwarted at the last minute by forces emanating from within our own U. S. government.

The existence of corrupt, top U.S. officials would also explain the opposition Gritz faced when he returned from the Golden Triangle in 1987 and first brought word of Khun Sa's offer to official Washington channels. The offer got nowhere. Gritz and his team were threatened by their superiors to keep their mouths shut, to forget what they had heard "or you're going to hurt the government."

Being a man who does not confuse love of country with love of its government, Gritz refused. He was subsequently indicted on passport violations - by the very government which had issued the false passport in the first place to enable him to carry out his mission in search of POW's. Another team member, Scott Weekly, was sent to the federal prison in Lompoc, California, on a similarly trumped-up charge.

Although Gritz persisted in telling the story in 1987 and '88, he was stonewalled at nearly every turn. In the spring of 1989 Gritz was acquitted. He then returned to the Shan province of Burma to meet once again with Gen. Khun Sa - this time without the blessing of the U. S. government.

Moreover, this time Gritz brought back with him two items to help ignite action on this front in the war on drugs: (1) the "Proposal for Eradication of, Opium from the Shan State 'Golden Triangle'" and (2) a videotape of Khun Sa appealing to America for help in legitimizing the Shan economy, and which witnesses the actual signing of the document by Khun Sa and the other members of the TRC (Tai Revolutionary Council), the free Shan government in exile, and by their Buddhist abbot.

Gritz reports that in addition to stopping the heroin traffic from the Golden Triangle,

"Khun Sa would also disclose the identity of every U. S. government official he had dealt with, officials he claims had been his best customers for the past 20 years."

Still smarting from official rejection and stonewalling in 1987 and '88, Gritz is determined to inform his fellow citizens of the treachery of certain U. S. officials and to stir the public to demand acceptance of Khun Sa's proposal.

"It's a win-win situation," stated Gritz. "Here we have an opportunity to win a major battle in the war on drugs, and at only a tiny fraction of the cost our government is now proposing to spend on it. It would be the height of stupidity not to accept Khun Sa's offer."

In order to assist individual citizens and groups to do more than sport bumper stickers urging "Just Say No", Gritz and some friends and supporters have organized The Center For Action, 711 Yucca Street, Boulder City, Nevada 89005, 1-800-293-3900. The Center For Action is asking help from American citizens and asking each to contact their Senator and Congressman requesting that General Khun Sa's offer be acted upon by Congress. Gritz will send Khun Sa's proposal and supporting documents for free.

"I know to some it might sound unrealistic," said Gritz, "but we've simply got to get serious about it. The 'Just Say No' campaign reminds me of President Gerald Ford's 'Whip Inflation Now' button and has been about as equally effective."

As just one example that the government's war on drugs has been a failure, Gritz cites a General Accounting Office study, as reported by the Washington Post's news service that "despite more than \$100 million in funding over the past four years, U.S. anti-drug efforts in Columbia and Bolivia have been entirely ineffective and the cultivation of drug crops has increased dramatically in both countries..."

Asked how "The Center for Action" would differ from other anti-drug efforts, Gritz responded: "Well, our first task is to help generate enough grass roots support to cause our elected officials in Washington to take action on Khun Sa's offer. If that exposes some rats and it takes another Watergate-style scandal in Washington to clean out the corruption, so be it," said Gritz.

"It's clear from my attempt two years ago to go it alone through official channels that it's going to take an aroused and informed citizenry - that's you and me and the other guy - to each do our part if we're going to win this war," Gritz asserted.

The sudden withdrawal of former Assistant Secretary of State Richard Armitage's nomination to be President Bush's Secretary of the Army was due to the fact that he would have faced some very probing questions about his activities in such matters as arms and drug smuggling by a Senate committee, according to Gritz, "and that was brought about by an aroused citizenry. We need to work in that direction to sweep America clean of drugs and drug dealers no matter how high up in government the criminals may sit."

"While the propaganda instruments of communist and non-communist governments urge their peoples to hate and fear their 'opposites,' there is clearly an established pattern of covert coordination and cooperation between the two forms of government. This is nowhere better illustrated than in the drug trade of the Golden Triangle."

"In the late 60s/early 70s CIA station chief in Laos and Vietnam, Theodore Shackley, under the direction of Nelson Rockefeller's former professor, Henry Kissinger, systematically hollowed out the leadership infrastructure of whole countries in southeast Asia's Golden Triangle only to have this richest poppy real estate turned over to communists. Now the Burmese communists, who our government supports, restrict all their territories to Westerners except for short visas to Rangoon. The same for Laos, Cambodia, and Vietnam. The poppies are grown in the restricted communist nations only for export to the West. How convenient."

"As clearly documented by Alfred McCoy, author of *The Politics of Heroin In Southeast Asia*, our CIA organized the heroin trade in the Golden Triangle by militarily suppressing all traffickers in each area except its chosen agent and by providing product transport via **Air America**, headed at one time by Gen. Richard Secord. These U.S. government-conferred monopolies transcended the communist takeovers. In the heroin trade of the Golden Triangle we see communist and non-communist governments working together like a hand and a glove."

"Because the CIA's involvement in the heroin trade transcends many presidencies it is necessary to look beyond presidents for the real power behind this heroin atrocity. There is a saying in Washington, 'The presidents come and go but the Rockefellers are forever.' The central role of Rockefeller operative Henry Kissinger in Southeast Asia makes it tempting to ask if perhaps David Rockefeller and the very power elite which he represents may-in the final analysis-be at the center of this vile narcotics trade."

"As for the so-called communist conspiracy, I have long maintained that the same individuals who pull the strings on the National Security Council also pull the strings on the Politburo. Reference page 163 of Antony Sutton's scholarly work, [Wall Street And The Bolshevik Revolution](#)."

"After meticulously documenting the long concealed fact that the richest men of the world financed the Bolshevik revolution (Rockefeller, Morgan, duPont, Mellon etc.) Sutton reveals how this same group created **United Americans**, a virulent anti-Soviet organization which loudly stated that the Reds were going to come and cut our throats in the night. Sutton concludes that to create world communism and then create and control the propaganda instruments and paramilitary organizations to 'fight' communism suggests utter moral depravity."

PROPOSAL FOR ERADICATION
OF OPIUM FROM THE SHAN STATE
GOLDEN TRIANGLE

I. OVERVIEW

As the expenditure of worldwide drug suppression funds grows so does the production and distribution of opium products. Billions of dollars have been spent to stop drugs, yet trafficking from the Golden Triangle has steadily escalated. In 1986 more than 900 tons passed through this area. The figure increased to 1,200 tons in '89. This year production will exceed 2,000 tons. Existing drug suppression programs aren't working. How do you think such enormous shipments can be exported from this underdeveloped region without the badges, credentials, clearances, and involvement of corrupt authorities? It can't and it isn't! Tax payer dollars only increase the incentives of those involved in drug suppression to increase the flow of narcotics.

There is a positive solution. By uprooting all opium plants there can be no processing of heroin. The problems associated with addiction go away disarming those who would legalize drugs. Within five to seven years, opium from the Golden Triangle can be extinct! We have the capability and the desire. We will do the work, but we need your help.

The TRC, Tai Revolutionary Council, has now unified all 35 Shan principalities and provides recognized leadership and representation over 8,000,000 Shan State people. The TRC is a legitimate government in exile, organized with a Constitution and functional branches patterned after the United States. Progress through free enterprise and TRC programs continues despite oppressive efforts by the Burmese Socialist and Communist parties.

The Shan State "Mong Tai" Army is an exceptionally disciplined, equipped, and spirited self defense force that secures our borders from all invaders. The solidarity of our free people insures our continued security. We control our region and the drugs that pass through it. We can stop the trafficking and eliminate all future growing. To do it only requires reasonable assistance and cooperation in replacing our economic dependency on poppies.

It must be remembered that we are not the genesis of the heroin problem. It was the British that exploited cultivation and passed laws to protect distribution of opium that addicted East Asia. During the French Indochina era drugs continued to be used for political & commercial advantage by foreign interests. The American CIA Colonel, Edward G. Lansdale reported in July 1953 to his superiors in Washington, D.C. that the French military had brought up the entire '53 opium harvest on orders of the French Commander-in-Chief, General Raoul Salan.

The opium was flown to Saigon for sale and export. Through the U.S. war in Vietnam, heroin production was accelerated to help finance CIA mercenary expansion campaigns in

Laos and Cambodia. It was further used to destroy the will of the American people at home and on the battlefields. Today the operation remains the same, only a few of the names have changed as people have died or been promoted.

After the communist takeover in 1975, the CIA stockpiled weapons in Thailand and the Philippines to continue operations in Southeast Asia. Heroin provides the means. Officials arrange the laundry of funds through international banks. Mafia contacts handle worldwide distribution. We were not surprised to learn of Mr. Richard Armitage's appointment as U.S. Assistant Secretary of State for East Asia. He is well known to us as a key member of the CIA drug team. His position over this part of the world will assure business as usual while securing his involvement.

It is because of this demand for heroin that we are prevented from establishing a legal economy. We Shans have been slaves to western government secret dealings which have poisoned the world's population. Our determination to free ourselves has led to this letter of appeal. We have been forced to rely on opium for our livelihood. The American DEA supplies the Burmese Socialists with aircraft, chemicals, and other resources which are used against our people, domestic animals, food, crops, and water. Public relations glorify suppression results while the world continues to overdose.

The Shan State proposal is clear, cost efficient, and conclusive! Total success will require only five to seven years depending upon the degree of external cooperation. We must have diplomatic support to restrain Burmese aggression, open commercial trade routes within Thailand, and legalize foreign access to our vast resources. We must have financial assistance to compensate growers as they uproot their poppy crops. Specialists will have to substitute legitimate alternatives. We will need help preparing for domestic and industrial expansion.

The following is a matrix outlining our plan for economic conversion.

III. CONCLUSION:


Let there be no mistake. We have the desire, will, ability, and stand ready to wipe out opium from the Golden Triangle. To do this will take some time, diplomatic cooperation, technical assistance, and money. We are not looking for a handout! The Japanese have correctly opined that "the Shan sleep on a bed of gold". Our untapped resources are well known. We are willing to share our wealth in exchange for the opportunity to chart our destiny as a free people. Thus far we have had no choice but to supply illegal products for ill use by greedy individuals, organizations, and government. We have been labled "the worlds worst criminals" by those who would keep us from obtaining our birthright. Their accusations are reflections of their own guilt. They have given us no option. To survive, we have had to satisfy their demands.

The Panglong Agreement of 1947 establishes our right to be an independent nationstate. We are as different from the Burmese as the French, Germans, English, Italians, Americans, and Mexicans are. "After viewing and reading his work, get busy and contact your congressman and all the media. Urge them to investigate the Gritz story. Nobody has ever proven Gritz wrong, but they have gone into a frenzy with charges that Gritz himself is 'unreliable,' 'not credible,' 'a grandstander.' OK, so prove him wrong. Stop the name-calling. Show that his facts are incorrect or without foundation. We suggest it can't be done. And that's very embarrassing to the phony 'War on Drugs' being espoused in DC."
