AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
Ordinance O-2015-43

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING O-2015-36 TO PROVIDE THAT THE NAMES OF THE
CANIDATES FOR THE CHARTER COMMISSION BE PRESENTED ON THE
BALLOT IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER, WAIVING THREE READINGS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio desires to create a charter form of government for the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village to amend how the charter commission candidate names shall appear on the ballot;

THE NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, two-thirds of its members concurring:

SECTION I. That Section IV of Ordinance O-2015-36 shall be deleted in its entirety.

SECTION II. That Section IV of Ordinance O-2015-36 shall be amended to read as follows

SECTION IV. The ballots to be printed for the election of persons to act as members of the charter commission shall contain the names of all candidates arranged in alphabetical order on all ballots.

SECTION III. Council hereby directs the Fiscal Officer to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Board of Elections of Clermont County, Ohio.

SECTION IV. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time in order to meet the Board of Election deadline for submission of the ballot language. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, the ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
