New Business: Wensel shared information from the NVJPC meeting. Wensel said the next meeting is here at Marion Township in January on the third Thursday.

Wensel said Benner Township is rewriting their zoning completely. It was discussed at NVJPC that the goals are being set to work on emergency management and public utilities - dry hydrants. There was discussion on these issues.

Dillon made a motion that the township do research and develop dry hydrants in this township and possible agreements with residents. Wensel seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

Dillon made a motion to recommend to the Supervisors that they look into the township rewriting an ordinance to help the fire companies re-coop money for emergency calls and incidents. Wensel seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.
