

## Year End Point System

(based similarly to the NRCHA system)

First place horse will receive the highest amount of points based upon the number of horses actually shown. In a class with 5 or more horses shown, the first place horse will receive 5 pts for the win plus 1 pt for every horse defeated. Each succeeding place will receive 2 pts less than the place before it.

For example: 10 horses in a class --- 1<sup>st</sup> place receives 14 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 12 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 10 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 8pts, 5<sup>th</sup> = 6pts, 6<sup>th</sup> = 4pts, 7<sup>th</sup> = 2 pts.

For each class having less than 5 entries, the 1<sup>st</sup> place horse will receive pts equal to the number of horses shown in the class plus 1 pt for every horse defeated.

For example: 4 horses shown --- 1<sup>st</sup> place received 4 pts plus 3 pts for 3 horses defeated, for a total of 7 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 5pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 3 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 1 pt.

We will not be awarding points for money earned.

In the Open, points will follow the horse, not the horse/rider. In the Non Pro and youth, points are attached to the horse/rider combination.
