

Tobermory Accommodations

There are no hotels available that can accommodate large groups so we are unable to "block" a group of rooms. However, Tobermory has experienced significant change since we last held our symposium on the Bruce Peninsula. There are numerous motels, cottages, B & B's, cabins etc. which did not exist in 2003. Most close for the winter and it's difficult to find someone to talk to until closer to the summer season. There are also a number of private homes suitable for sharing which can reduce the cost significantly. There are several campgrounds nearby as well.

Tobermory has geared-up for tourism. The internet can be your best friend ... be sure to visit www.tobermory.com and go to the "accommodations" page. Use Google, Trivago, Airbnb etc. to locate lodging that suits your needs. Prices in the area are a bit on the high side ranging from \$90 to more than \$200 (Canadian) per night.
