## This year two \$500 scholarships are being offered through the generosity of the Frank and Kathy Muse and the Schmitt families

Scholarships are available to Shasta County students, current or former, who are pursuing training in diesel mechanics, welding, or equipment operations. The applicant must plan on attending college next year, carrying 12 or more units.

The scholarship is available to both high school seniors and current college students and is not based on financial need. Applicants will be selected based on cumulative results of the application elements listed below.

- 1. A transcript of the high school work or current year of college.
- 2. One letter of recommendation must be attached to application. Applicant is limited to one letter of recommendation written by a school employee. Relatives may not be used as references.
- 3. A completed application form.
- 4. A photograph must be attached with your application and a digital copy emailed to <a href="mailto:shastacountyfarm1@gmail.com">shastacountyfarm1@gmail.com</a>.

## To be considered complete, the above items must be included in the application packet.

Applications must be <u>RECEIVED</u> at the Farm Bureau no later than March 15, 2022. Applications received after that date will not be considered. There are no exceptions.

The recipients will be awarded a Certificate at the Shasta County Farm Bureau 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Spring Social on April 2, 2022 at the Shasta District Fair & Event Center.
