

Antigo Wednesday Night Sandlot Volleyball Rules

- Two divisions.
 - Black Division.
 - More competitive. Spiking and overhand serves allowed.
 - Blue Division.
 - Less competitive. Hard spiking not allowed and serves must have an arc.
 - Any interdivisional games must adhere to Blue Division rules.
- Each volleyball match will consist of three games.
- Maximum of six players on the court per team.
 - Teams can rotate, sub, or play with less than six players as long as the female rule applies.
 - Teams with four players or less require at least one female.
 - Teams with five or six players require at least two females.
 - If a team is unable to have one female player, the game can still be played if the opposing team agrees. If not, the team without the female player will have to forfeit. Please avoid forfeits.
- Touching the net during the play is a foul.
- Spike return of the serve is a foul.
- Carrying is a judgment call; please resolve it on the spot.
- Three hits maximum. A block is not a hit.
- Any disputes replay the point.
- Volley to serve or pick side for the first game. Volley must cross net three times.
- Loser serves the second game and sides are rotated.
- If 2-0, losers serve the 3rd game. If 1-1, teams volley for serve.
