

Parvo Addendum to Health Guarantee & Puppy Sale Contract

As a Breeder/Seller I have kept your puppy safe from the parvovirus. Now it is your turn. Follow these guidelines to continue to keep your puppy safe:

If you are traveling long distance do not take your puppy to the pet area when you stop at a rest area. These areas are filled with all kinds of germs from thousands of dogs. Instead bring a dog crate with several puppy pads and let your puppy go on the pad, simply change the pad regularly. Your puppy is familiar with using a pad, this will be very natural to them.

Don't take your puppy to pet stores, pet parks or other public places until they have had their **third shot**.

Don't let your puppy run around in the yard if you don't know for sure it has never had parvovirus in it before. The parvovirus can last up to **8 years**.

For the health and safety of your new puppy, be very cautious.

Don't let friends and relatives from outside your home handle and play with the puppy until **all shots** are given. Parvovirus can be carried in on shoes and clothing. It cannot be seen.

Keep your puppy in a sanitized puppy playpen or a confined area when not holding them. Clean and sanitize their space regularly until after they've had third shot.
