Services and burial for retired U. S. Air Force Col. Lester G. Taylor Jr., 59, Flemington, N. J., formerly of Kansas City, Kan., were Sept. 11 in Flemington.

Mr. Taylor died Sept. 8 at Hunterdon Medical Center, Flemington. He was born in KCK and was a resident here until he attended West Point in 1940. He was graduated from West Point in 1943.

He was a fighter pilot in the European Theater and served in the Korean War.
