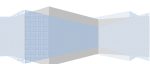

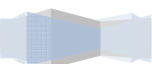

- Highway 10 is the main highway to Regina, east to the Manitoba border and is intersected by highway 52.

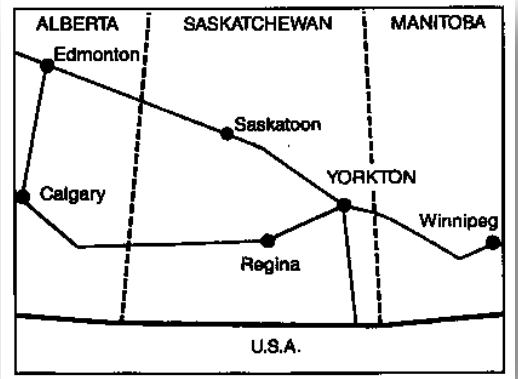

- Connection with CNR transcontinental main line at Melville (38 km southwest)

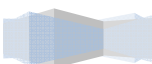

National Doukhobour Heritage Village and Museum

In 1982 the province of Saskatchewan declared the Doukhobour Prayer Home a Provincial Heritage Building. The Verigin Doukhobour Prayer Home is a landmark of the area, with architecture that can be traced to the mid-1800's in Russia. The home was built in 1917 and is currently part of the National Doukhobour Heritage Village. Many buildings make up this unique village. Visitors can view a "peche" (brick oven), a "banya" (bathhouse) and several household articles and utensils that can be found in the homes. The Museum and Administration Building holds Doukhobour artifacts, ranging from photos and handicrafts to clothing and hand tools. Barns, a blacksmith shop and a collection of agricultural equipment complete this Heritage Village. It is truly one of a kind and well worth the drive!

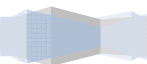

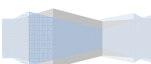
Sunflower Arts and Crafts Show
