

# APPLICATION & ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO CHURCH OFFICE BY OR ON JUNE 15, 2020

#### Requirements are the following:

- High School Seniors OR current College or Graduate Students are eligible to apply.
- Applicant must be a son/daughter of a steward of St. Spyridon Greek Orthodox Church.
- For High School Seniors: Copy of acceptance letter to accredited college.
- An official high school transcript OR copy of last semester of college transcript with school's
  official seal.
- Two letters of recommendation: the first from a teacher or professor, advisor, counselor or dean; the second – applicant's choice. The letters of recommendation must be on school letterhead.
- The St. Spyridon Philoptochos reserves the right to award more than one scholarship in the same academic year, based on required qualifications, grades, and service projects of the applicant.
- A St. Spyridon Philoptochos Scholarship will not be awarded to anyone who received the St. Spyridon PTA Scholarship in the same academic year.
