DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing recurve. The Golden Emperor had the same basic design as the 65 Lord Mercury and the Lord Sovereign. Brazilian Rosewood riser with phenolic accents (Brazilian Rosewood has been banned for decades now but was the riser material of choice for high-end bows back in the day). The bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. Two small professionally filled sight holes on the back (see pic). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress cracks or crazing. A few minor scratches and scuffs here and there. You can see a worn area near the rest button (see pic). Decals are in near mint condition. Overall, this is an exceptional bow in excellent condition for its age.
