Chimney Rock Special Congregation Meeting on December 2nd affirmed the recommendation of Congregation Council to withdraw from the Tri-Parish for financial reasons effective February 1, 2019 by a 26 yes to 4 no vote. The Congregation Council at its December 13th meeting deliberated options for pastoral services.

Confirmation resumes on January 2^{nd} at 4pm at Trinity of Norden and 6pm at Good Shepherd. There will be no confirmation on January 30^{th} .

Epiphany of Our Lord is on Sunday, January 6th. Epiphany means "manifestation." On this day, we celebrate the revelation of Christ to all the nations in the magi's adoration of the Christ Child.

Baptism of Our Lord is on Sunday, January 13th to remember our baptism. Jesus is revealed as the Son of God in the waters of the River Jordan. In the Sacrament of Holy Baptism those washed by the water are called "fellow members of the body of Christ, children of the same heavenly father, and workers with us in the kingdom of God." A special invitation is extended to the families with a baptism this past year. Come to the service of worship to commemorate the Baptism of Our Lord and your baptism!

Service of Prayer for Christian Unity is on Sunday, January 20th. This parish will be joining Christians throughout the world in a Service of Prayer for Christian Unity as a part of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity January 18th-25th. Pray for the unity of the church!

Pastor Bolstad will be attending Synod Winter Theological event on January 20th-21st in Eau Claire. Speaking at this event will be Dwight Zscheile, an Episcopal priest, associate professor of congregational mission and leadership at Luther Seminary in St. Paul, Minnesota, and consultant with The Missional Network. He also serves part-time as associate priest at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in St. Paul. He is author of The Agile Church: Spirit-Led Innovation in an Uncertain Age (Morehouse Publishing, 2014). Dwight's experience growing up in a secular home in California has shaped his commitment to helping the church cultivate Christian community with new populations and generations in today's changing world. The churches of the future will be adaptive learning communities, that learn from "failing fast and flipping." The church of the future will be agile and engaged in constant experimentation, innovation, and evaluation. Rostered leaders of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin are invited to come together for a midwinter break and a time of learning and conversation about how God might be calling us to faithfully explore ministry in new and creative ways. This event is expected of all rostered ministers.

NRS Parish Council Minutes - October 29th - Unapproved

The Norden-Rock-Shepherd Parish (NRS Parish) council met on October 29,2018 at 6:30pm at Trinity of Norden Church.

Council Members Present: Brad Olson, Missy Ostertag, Lori Rud, John Hovey, Forrest Nutter, Dave Larson, Neil Segerstrom, Lisa Wulff, Parish Office Assistant Jennifer Perry, Parish Treasurer Marla Severson, Pastor Bolstad.

- 1. Meeting was opened by President Brad Olson.
- 2. Devotions based on Genesis reading were lead by Pastor Bolstad.
- 3. Secretary's Report read by Missy O. Motion made by Dave L. and 2nd by Lisa W. to approve the report. Motion Carried.
- 4. Treasurer Report was read by Marla S. noting that expenses have remained the same. Motion by Missy O. and 2nd by Dave L to approve. Motion carried.
- 5. Old Business was discussion and approval of 2019 budget. Brad O. brought forward that CR council met and due to financial concerns within their parish, they cannot guarantee to have monies available to stay in a Tri-parish agreement. The CR council voted at their last meeting to break away from the Tri-parish and their church will be holding a congregational vote in early December. Pending that vote, the NRS parish will be officially notified of that decision. John H. informed the council that GS council voted to stay in a Tri-parish with the emphasis that monies will be tight but they could financially make it work. Marla S. told the council that TR is financially stable at this time to stay in a Tri-parish agreement. Pending the official vote of the CR congregation, the Tri-parish agreement would end February 1, 2019. GS and TR will meet Wednesday November 28th at 7pm at GS to begin discussion of continuing a partnership for pastoral needs. Pastor Bolstad agreed to continue his interim with just two churches.
- 6. New Business items discussed were the 2019 Worship schedule. Due to the strong possibility of CR leaving the Tri-parish February 1, 2019, a motion was made by Dave L. and 2nd by Lisa W. to extend the Nov/Dec worship schedule thru the end of January 2019 with worship schedule for February 2019 onward TBD at a later date. Motion Carried.
- 7. An audit committee is needed to audit the NRS Tri-parish Books. Motion by Dave L. and 2nd by John H. to have Forrest N, Lori R., and Neil S. on that committee. Date to be set in December for audit date in January. Motion carried.
- 8. Other business discussed was compensation and insurance changes for Pastor Bolstad. Motion made by Lisa W. and 2nd by John H. to place additional compensation change due to medicare insurance premium into Pastor Bolstad's pension. Motion carried with one abstaining. Pastor Bolstad was informed that there is \$500 in the Tri-parish budget for him at attend official pastoral meetings.
- 9. Upcoming meetings: GS and TR Tri-parish council members will meet Wed. Nov. 28th at 7pm at GS to begin discussion of continuing a partnership for pastoral needs. The next NRS Parish council will meet on Wednesday January 16,2019 at 7:30 at Trinity of Norden.
- 10. Motion by Dave L. and 2nd by Neil S to adjourn. Motion carried.

Chimney Rock Council Minutes - December 13, 2018

The Congregational Council of Chimney Rock Church was called to order at 6:00pm on Thursday, December 13, 2018, by Council President Bradley Olson. Members present: Interim Pastor Lowell Bolstad, Alan Barneson, Gerald Hawkenson, Bradley Olson, Mary Olson, Don Solfest. Members Absent: Jenessa Perry, Randy Olson

Others Present: Jackie Hawkenson

Pastor Bolstad read devotions and led the group in prayer.

The Pastor's report was read. Transition Dynamics were discussed, specifically Leadership. Discussion centered on the ways the Congregational Council members could engage the members of the congregation in God's mission. There are three main types of activities that Congregational Council members work on. They are:

- 1. Fiduciary- stewardship of our tangible assets.
- 2. Strategic- setting priorities and deploying resources in accordance with priorities.
- 3. Generative- problem framing and sense making about the shifting environment of the congregation. (long term planning)

We reviewed Chapter 12, Congregational Council, of Chimney Rock Constitution, which specifies duties of the Council. With two open Trustee slots on the Council needing to be filled, it is an opportunity to engage new people to become involved. As a Council, we need to encourage congregation members to move forward as a unified body, respecting each other and welcoming all.

At the December 2 Congregational meeting, it became evident to the Congregational Council that we are not communicating well enough with parish members. We discussed additional methods of sharing information. The Council meeting Minutes are published on our Facebook page, as well as set out in hardcopy in the Narthex of the church. Emails are sent out to congregation members. Financial information has not been/will not be published over the Internet and will be set out in the Narthex of the church in hardcopy each month. Monthly or possibly more often, one of the Council members will share Council information with the congregation during services.

The Secretary's Report was read and approved.

The Treasurer's Report was read and approved.

Old Business:

- 1. The Congregational vote on remaining in or withdrawing from the TriParish Agreement results were:
 - 26 members voted to withdraw from the TriParish
 - 4 members voted to remain in the TriParish

Effective February 1, 2019, Chimney Rock will withdraw from the TriParish Agreement.

2. Church front steps are awaiting repair.

New Business:

1. Brad Olson will be contacting Paul Tobiason, who has expressed an interest in serving as CR Pastor. Pastor Tobiason handles Sunday services three times a month, and is currently serving at Independence Lutheran, whom we would share him with. We would need to find a Lay Minister or other Pastor for one Sunday of each month. Financially, Chimney Rock has a maximum of \$1,500 a month that we can afford to pay for Pastoral services.

Don moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:53pm.

Pastor Bolstad led all in the Lord's Prayer.

Next Council meeting will be on Thursday, January 10, at 6:30pm. The Annual Congregational Meeting will be held after services on January 27, 2019.
