

Lu – Corts Morley J Moose III Supply List

-Morley J Moose III pattern by bj Designs.

-1/4 yard each of blue & teal (for top and bottom strips) for background

-1/8 yard of 6 other fabrics for background

-1/2 yard for border & binding

-6-10 fat quarters for Moose and/or scraps for variety

-1 & 1/4 yard for backing

- 3 yards fusible web ( I like Steam a seam 2 LITE)

-1 yard lightweight stabilizer

-Neutral thread for piecing

-Thread that matches or accents the moose for machine applique

-Sewing machine that can zig zag or has a blanket stitch.

-Basic sewing supplies

Before class work:

-Cut backgrounds into 3 & 1/2" strips: 2 each of blue & teal, 1 each of other 6.

-Sew together in the order that is pleasing to your eye starting with teal and blue and ending with teal and blue. The pattern covers this under "background". (If you are uncertain, you can wait and do the sewing in class.)

-Lay lightweight stabilizer over the front of the large paper pattern of Morley and trace all lines and numbers onto the stabilizer. He will be constructed on the stabilizer.

-Using a light box or sliding glass door, trace Morley on the reverse side of the large paper pattern, marking all lines and numbers. Write REVERSE on this side of the pattern.

-Set aside a piece of stabilizer that is 12" x 44" we'll use in class.

-Trace the shapes from the reverse side onto your fusible web, moving the stabilizer as you do so that you have 1/2" between all of the pencil lines.
