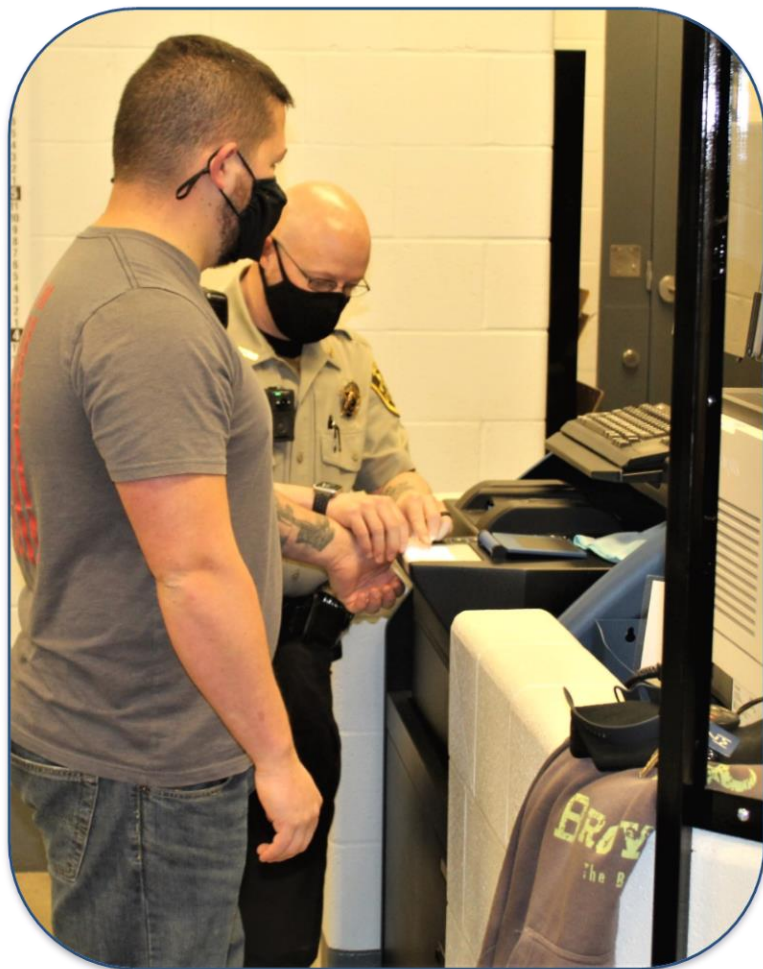

INTRODUCTION

The report contains alcohol-related information collected in all twenty-three counties in the State of Wyoming for a period of twelve months (January 1 through December 31, 2020) by the Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police. Information was collected from a total of 7,955 persons who were arrested and subsequently detained in a county detention facility. It also includes statistics from 153 persons booked into the VOA Center of Hope in Fremont County, which has recently transitioned into a long-term rehabilitation facility. VOA's data is now included within Fremont County's section.

This report provides detailed county specific alcohol-related information and is a supplement to the Alcohol and Crime in Wyoming – 2020¹ report.

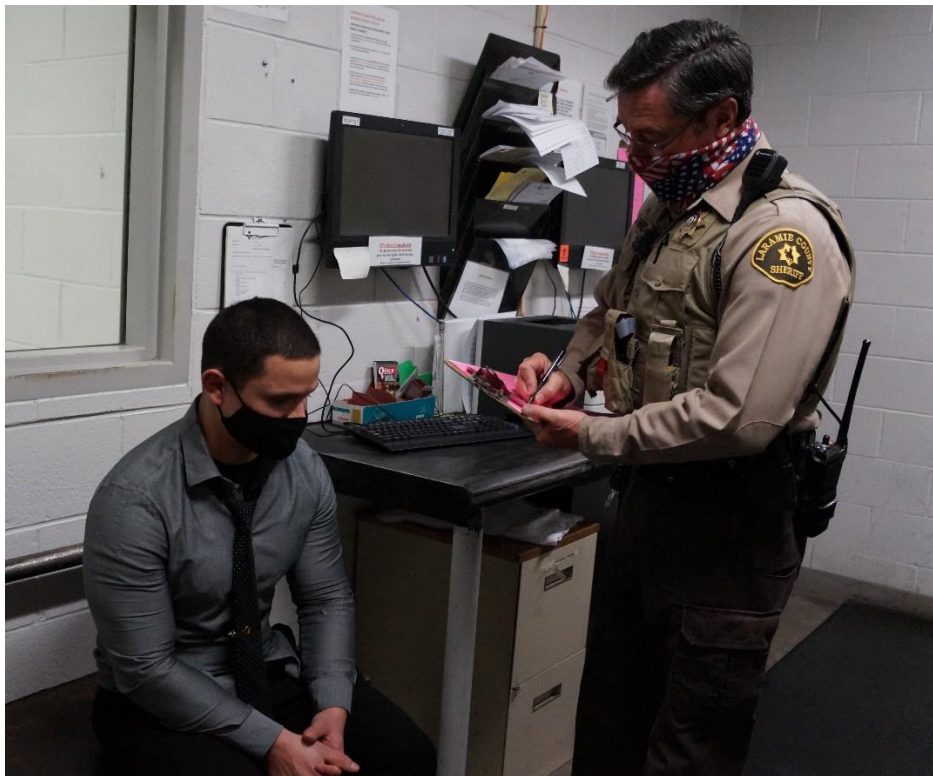
