THE PROGRAM: Literacy-Language Enrichment Apraxia/Articulation Program (LLEA/AP)©

The LLEA/AP© summer program is designed to provide *intensive* intervention for preschoolers with a diagnosis of Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS), Phonological Disorders, or Severe to Moderate Articulation Disorders. At present, there are no definitive diagnostic features that separate CAS from other speech sound disorders including phonological delays (ASHA 2016).

Participants will engage in researched based interventions that facilitate motor planning to improve sequencing sounds from simple forms to more complex words and phrases.

The LLEA/AP© program will provide remediation of preschoolers with mild to moderate language delays, fine motor delays and difficulties with sensory processing while addressing the fundamental underlying weakness in the pre-reading readiness to prepare the child to meet the academic demands of kindergarten.

Participants
