SCRAPPY FLYING GEESE BLOCK LOTTO APRIL 2023

Quilt block 8 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" unfinished



Color way: Scrappy (for sky and for geese).

You will need:

 $2 - 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " print rectangle $4 - 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " background square

Note: I recommend cutting your fabric ½" larger and square blocks prior to assembly to ensure your block comes out correctly.

Basic Flying Geese – Produces 1 block

The instructions below will produce 1- $4\frac{1}{2}x 8\frac{1}{2}$ unfinished block. You will make 2 blocks to create a $8\frac{1}{2}x 8\frac{1}{2}$ unfinished block.

Step 1. On the wrong side of 4 - 4 ¹/₂" squares draw a guideline from corner to corner. See fig.A below.

Step 2. Place one square right side down on the $4 \frac{1}{2}x 8 \frac{1}{2}$ rectangle. Sew along the guideline. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ from the seam and press out.

Step 3. Repeat step 2 with the other 4 ¹/₂" square. See fig.B below.

Step 4. Repeat steps 1-3 for second block.

Step 5. Sew the two blocks together to produce 8 ¹/₂' x 8 ¹/₂" unfinished block.
