Flag/Tag rugby is a fun and exciting form of non-contact rugby, suitable for both boys and girls.

The non-contact nature of the game, combined with the fun of the sport, means children will enjoy tag rugby while developing skills such as; passing, evading, ball handling and also a fantastic opportunity to be part of a team.

Our flag program is open to boys and girls that will be in Grade 1-9 in fall (currently in grades K-8). It's a team sport that can be played by experienced and non-experienced players alike, with the added benefit of social interaction & sportsmanship all mixed in.

PLAYER FEES: \$50 prior to May 1 or \$65 after. Includes all training sessions, team t-shirt, and a choice of a rugby ball or backpack.

TRAINING: (June 10 to July 29): We will train Wednesdays in Bellevue at Willow Creek Park. Grades 1-4 at 5:30-6:45pm and Grades 5-9 at 6:30-7:45pm

TOURNAMENTS: We play in four optional one-day tournaments in Oshkosh, Milwaukee, Fond du Lac and Green Bay. Players participating in these events will have a one-time \$20 fee for uniform shorts and socks (which you keep), and a \$5 per tournament fee. Everyone who attends tournaments will play!

EQUIPMENT: The only equipment you need is a pair of soccer or football cleats. Team jerseys are provided for use in tournaments and can be purchased at the end of the season.
